BACKGROUND

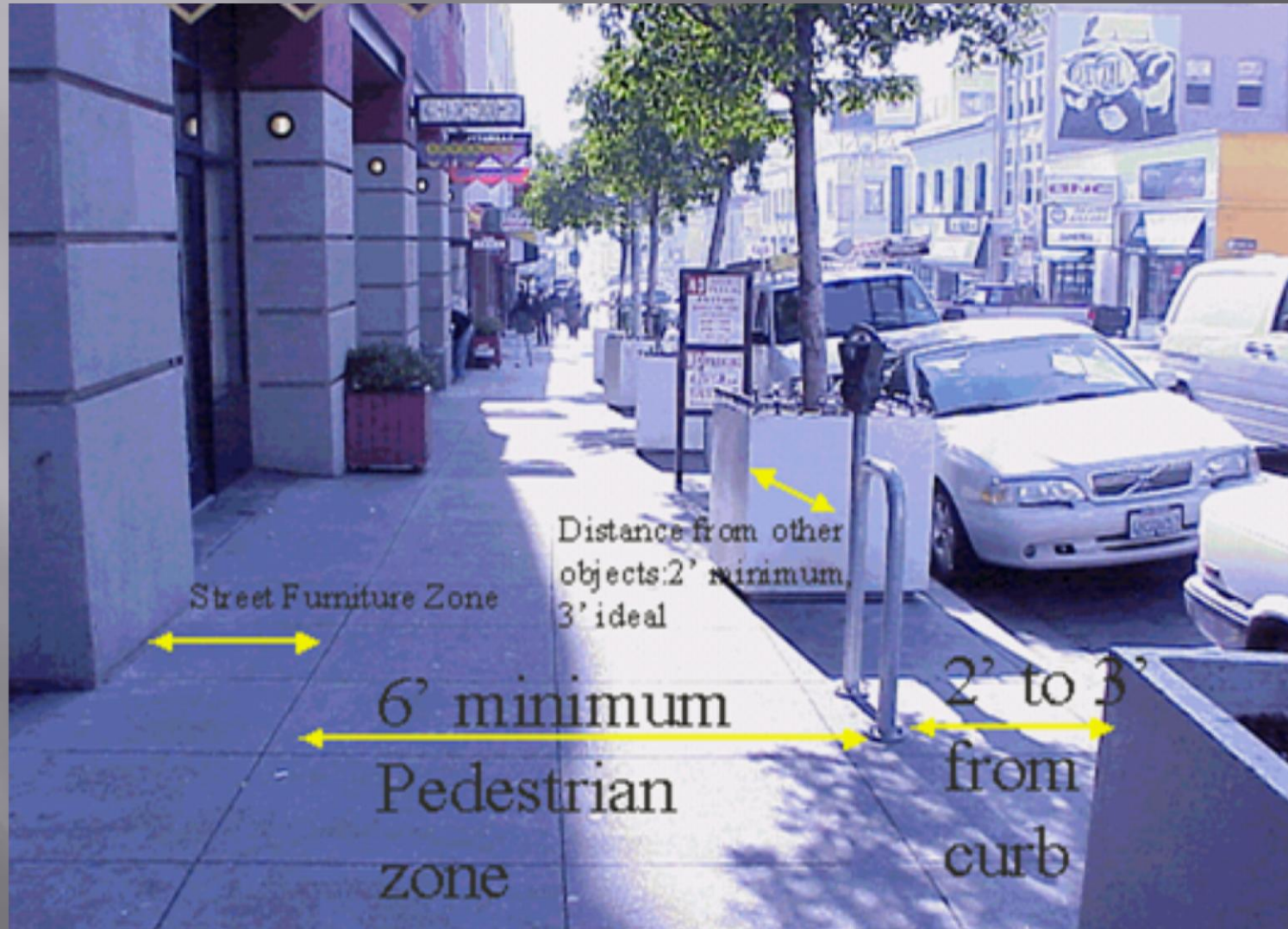
- ▣ Rack-on-request is a program found in several other cities. (Los Angeles)
- ▣ Businesses can request for the installation of a bicycle rack on the public right-of-way near their property.
- ▣ Eligibility is based off the geometric guidelines as well as the need for the rack in that location.

Geometric Guidelines

- ▣ Requirements :
 - 9 ft away from the building.
 - 2-3 ft away from the curb.
 - 2-3 ft away from any other object.
 - If located at a corner, 5 ft away from crosswalk.

- ▣ A bike rack cannot be installed if the location fails to meet these criteria.

Space Requirements



The Need for a Bike Rack

- ▣ Another criterion that determines eligibility is the *need* for a bike rack.
- ▣ If a specific application shows no need for a bike rack in its location, then the application is denied.
- ▣ The need for a bike rack will be determined by city staff with knowledge on bicycle rack implementation.

Application Process

- ▣ The application will be available on the city website and will ask for information including:
 - Name of the business.
 - Address.
 - Contact person.
 - Telephone number and email.
 - The number of racks required.
- ▣ Application can be submitted online or sent by mail to the Department of Public Works and Transportation.

Implementation

- ▣ After eligibility is determined, a field check will take place to determine if and where the bike rack will be installed.
- ▣ 3-4 hours and 2-3 Public Works staff are required for installation.
- ▣ It will take approximately 3-4 weeks from receipt of application.

Costs

- ▣ The city and the applicant will share the costs of installment.
- ▣ The cost of each bike rack installment depends on the type and size of rack that will be installed.
