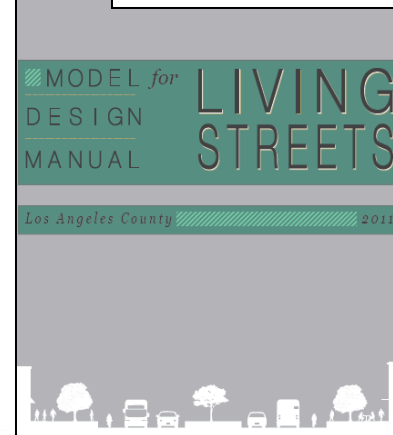
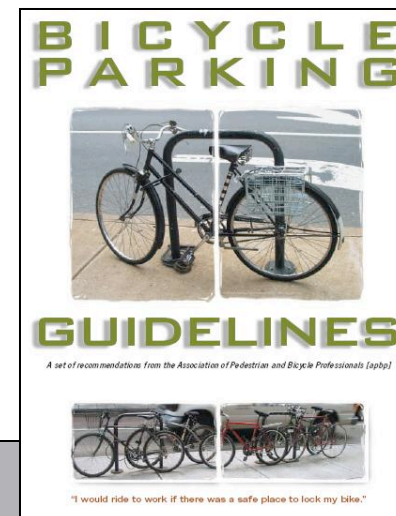

One rack element supports two bikes.

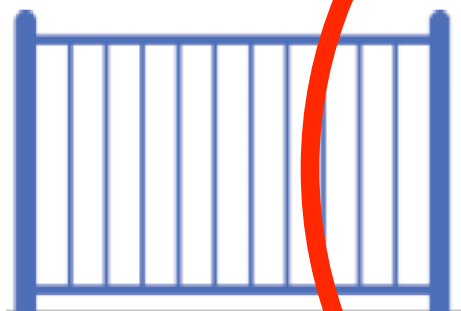


POST AND LOOP

One rack element supports two bikes.

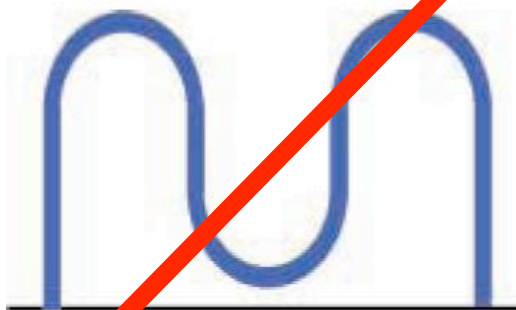

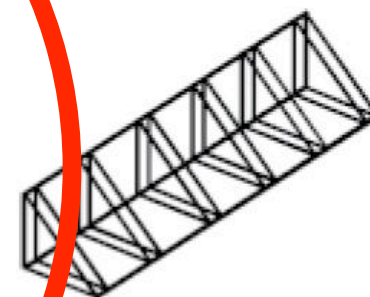
COMB

One rack element is a vertical segment of the rack.



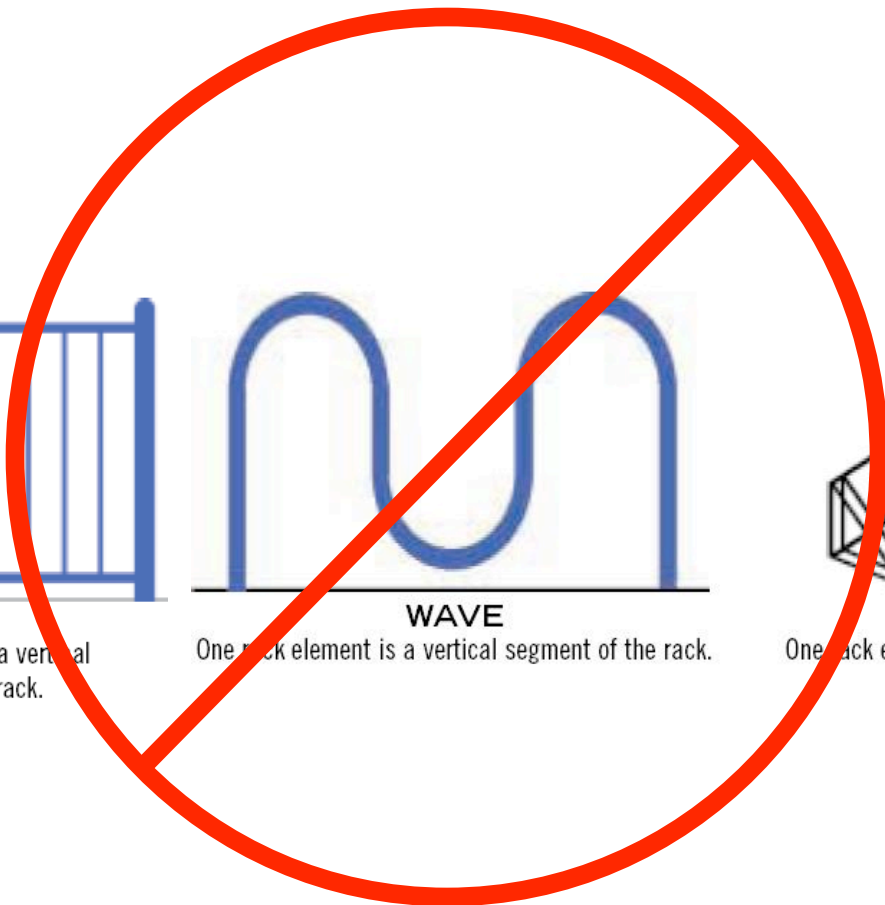
WAVE

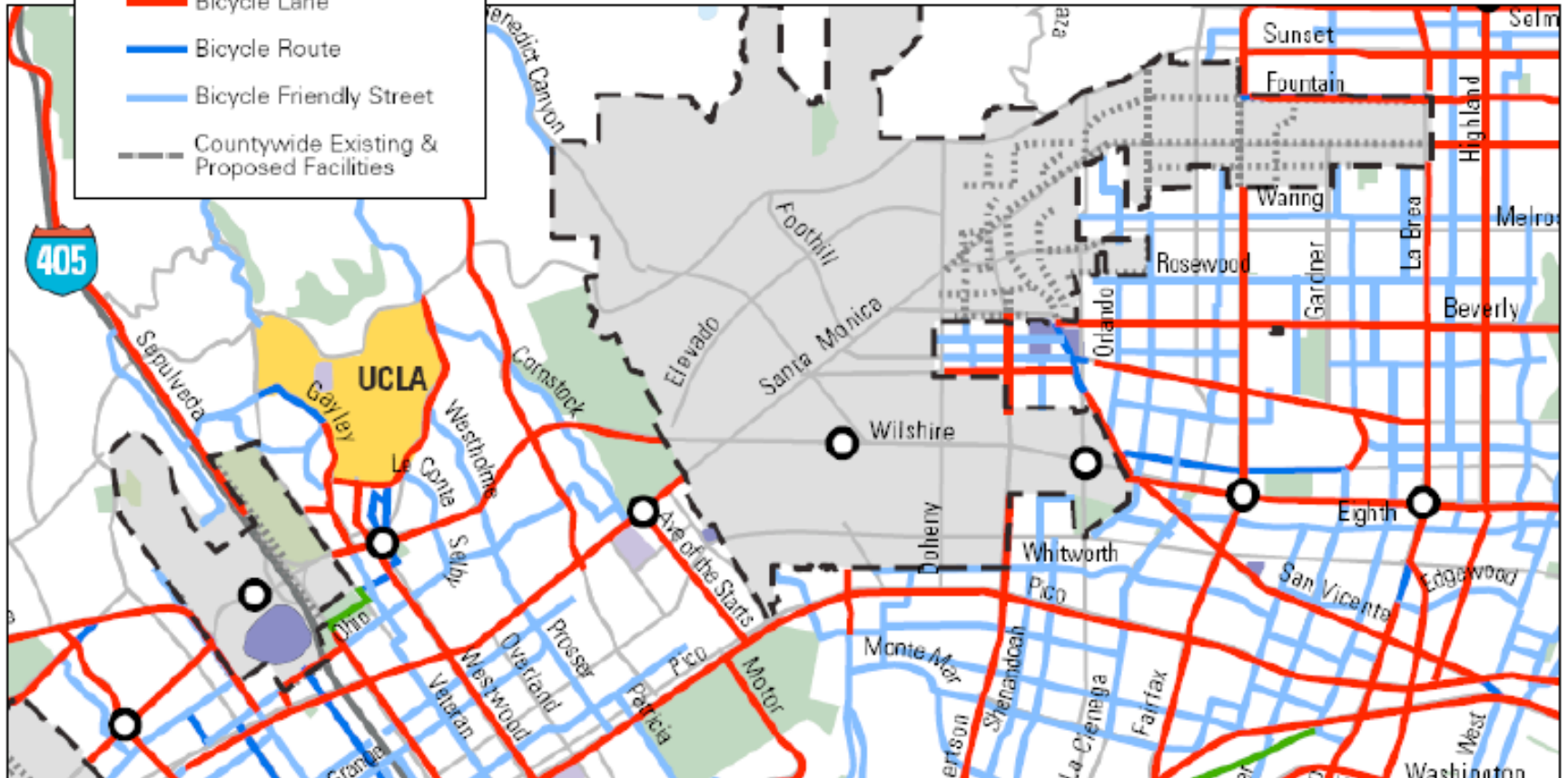

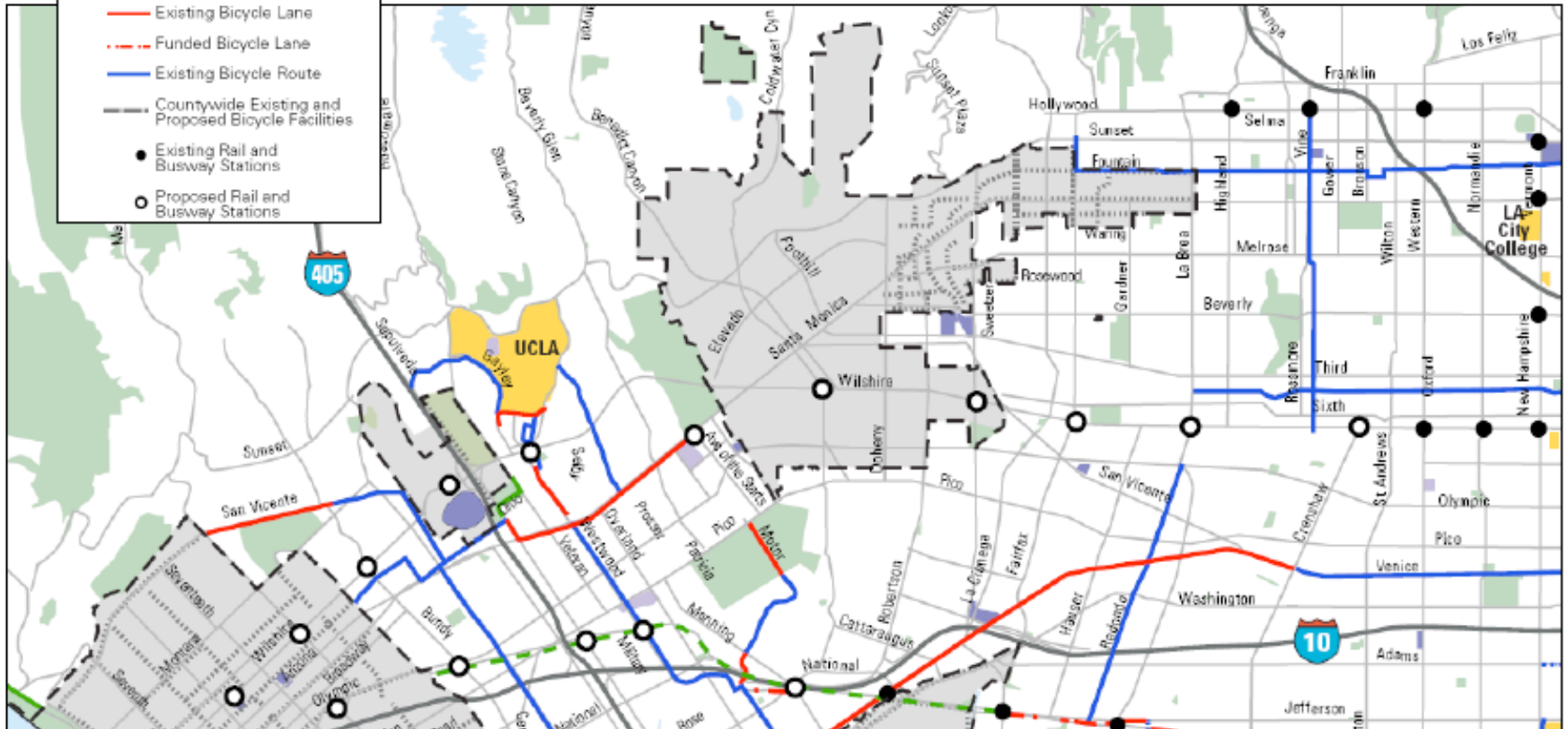

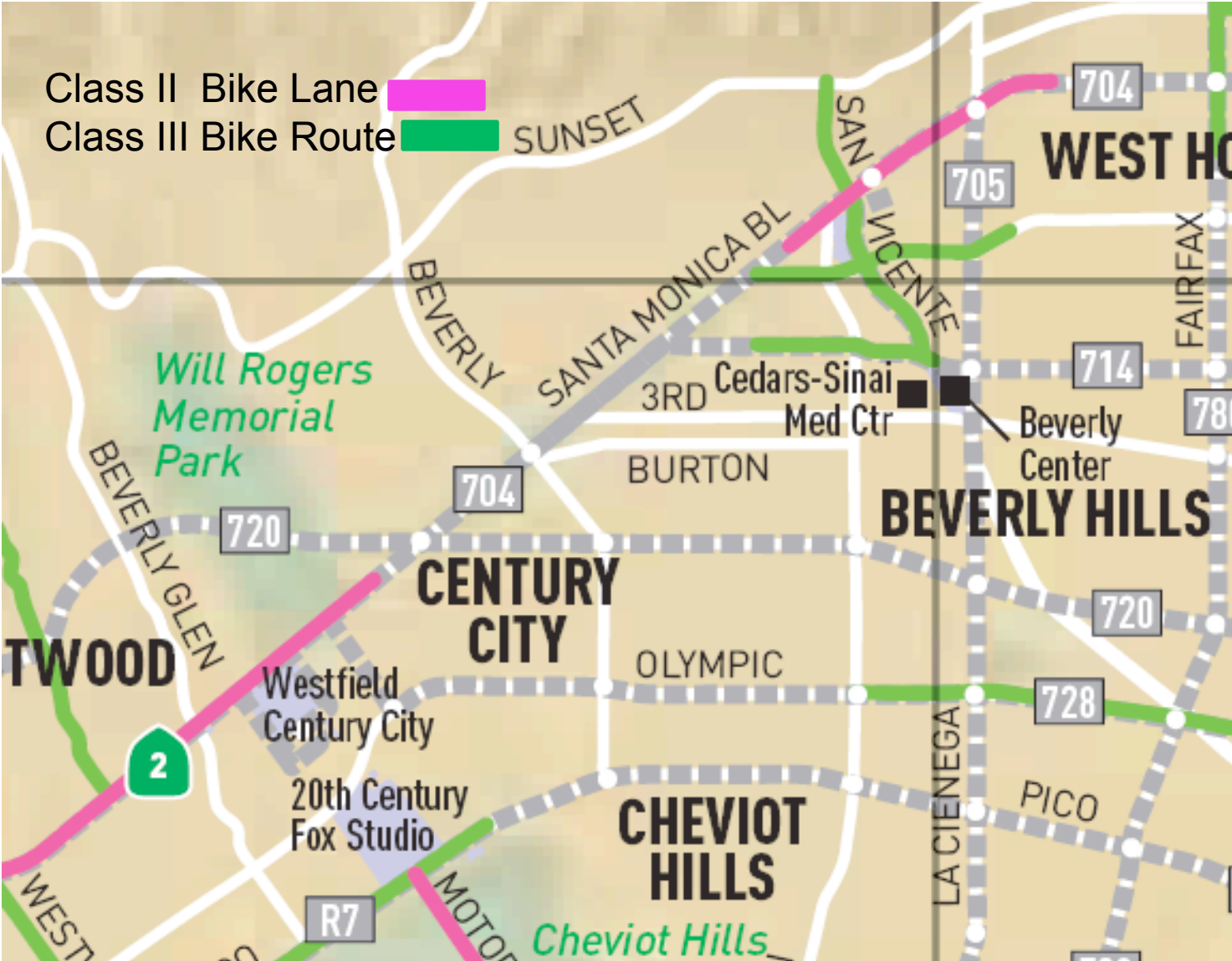
