## **Two Incumbents Are Only Candidates Who Filed to Run for Beverly Hills City Council Seats**

Beverly Hills, CA – The deadline for entering the 2015 Beverly Hills City Council municipal election has passed and two incumbents are the only candidates who have filed papers to fill two open seats. At 5 p.m. on Dec. 5, 2014, the filing period closed and Mayor Lili Bosse and Vice Mayor Julian Gold are the only candidates who have returned their nomination papers and met the requirements to run for office by the filing deadline. The City Council will consider whether to cancel the March 3, 2015 municipal election.

The residents of Beverly Hills elect five City councilmembers to serve four-year terms. Elections are held in March of odd-numbered years, with either three or two seats open. The 2015 municipal election was projected to cost the City approximately \$250,000.
