Good Afternoon:

The Beverly Hills City Council will continue the review of the Santa Monica Boulevard reconstruction project at the July 21st Study Session. A presentation of the project at the 50% design drawing phase focusing on: 1) widening on the south side of the roadway between Canon Drive and Wilshire Boulevard; 2) drainage concepts; 3) medians; 4) street lights; and 5) traffic mitigation during construction will be provided.

At the January 6, 2015 Study Session, Council directed staff to return to City Council at 50% project design with recommendations to widen the roadway on the south side in the 60-foot section between Wilshire and Canon Drive up to 3 feet and/or configuring the lane widths to potentially accommodate multi-modal uses (vehicles, buses and bicycles). The design team is prepared to proceed with designing a 62'-4" roadway in this section pending City Council's direction. As a comparison, the existing roadway between Doheny Drive and Canon Drive is currently 63 feet.
